# **Small Group Instruction (Guided Writing)**

Teacher provides explicit instruction and continuous feedback during all stages of the writing process as needed to individual students or small groups of students.

## **Guided Writing**

- Gives the teacher the opportunity to plan for the needs of students
- Provides students an opportunity to practice
- Allows time for the teacher to work with small groups or individuals

#### Teacher's Role

- Provides explicit teaching (through mini-lessons) based on the needs of students
- Models aspects of writing such as writer's craft, conventions, skills, and strategies as well as the writing process
- Provides lessons to the whole group, followed by small group instruction or individual conferences
- Allows the opportunity to conference with individuals to determine their needs
- Shares different genres to generate formats for writing
- Gives feedback during conferences and share time

#### Students' Role

- Select topics for writing
- Apply knowledge learned through on-going mini-lessons
- Conference with teacher and peers
- Share writing during Debrief/Share Time to receive feedback and encouragement
- Publish writing when appropriate

#### Resources

- · Variety of literature for modeling
- Chart paper (for modeling in the primary grades)
- Writing folders

- Writer's Notebooks (intermediate grades)
- Writing supplies (Ex. blank books, markers, staplers, etc.)
- Promethean Board
- Electronic device (for composing and/or publishing-- if applicable)

### **Procedures**

- Brief mini-lesson (10-20 minutes) This is a whole class lesson based on the needs of the students
- Student Work Time / Independent Writing (20-40 minutes) based on grade level

<u>Conferring</u>– during this time the teacher conferences with individual students on a rotating basis. Small group work can also be done at this time if needed.

 Debrief / Share Time (5-10 minutes) – The whole class gathers during this time as selected students share their work.
